
Objectives: The school recognises its responsibility to provide a safe and healthy environment and will take all reasonably practicable steps within its power to fulfil this responsibility.

To achieve this aim, the school will pursue the following objectives:

- To identify risks and take action to remove or reduce those risks.
- To establish and maintain a healthy environment throughout the school premises.
- To establish and maintain safe working procedures among the staff and students.
- To plan arrangements for ensuring safety and absence of risks to health in connection with the use, handling and storage of articles and substances.
- To ensure the provision of sufficient information, instruction, training and supervision to enable all staff and students, to avoid hazards and to contribute positively to their own health and safety.
- To formulate effective procedures in case of fire and other emergencies and for evacuating/locking down the school premises as necessary.
